- Sign letters and return next day



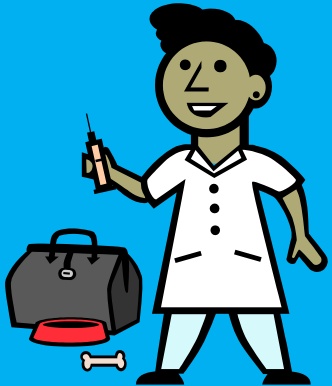
# Rewards and Consequences

- Complete work at lunchtime



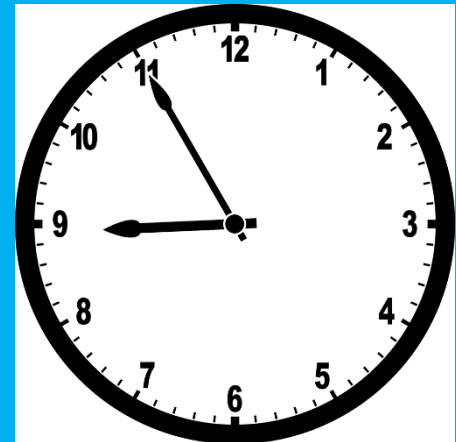
# Absences
