

### Communication and language

- Listening attentively in a range of situations, commenting and asking questions about what they hear.
- Following instructions involving several actions.
- Answering and how and why questions.
- To use the past, present and future tense correctly when talking about events.

### Physical development

- Fundamental movement skills including hopping, skipping, jumping, throwing and catching, kicking, rolling and balancing.
- To correctly form the letters of the alphabet in the school handwriting style.
- To handle tools including a needle safely and with control.
- Understanding of how and why it is important to keep healthy.
- Keeping safe - Right Start Pedestrian Training.

### Personal, social and emotional development

- Developing the children's confidence to talk about and share their ideas when working on a group task.
