Here are some more ideas of things you can do at home.

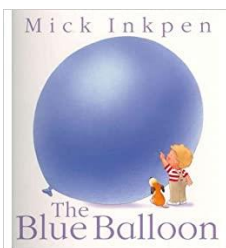
