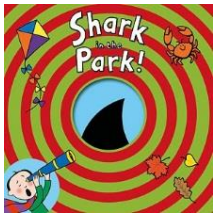


Hello Reception Superstars! I am sure that you have all been being good and that the Easter Bunny came and left you some Easter treats!

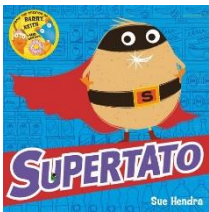


Here are some more fun things for you to do at home. Remember 'Superstars work hard'!
