

Hello again!

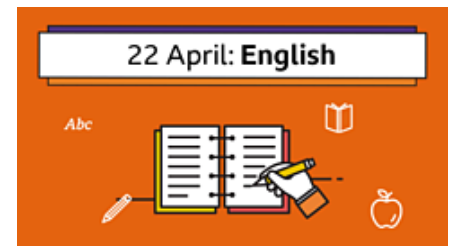
I hope you are enjoying the work about Julia Donaldson's characters. Remember if you haven't got her stories at home you can follow the links to listen to them online.
