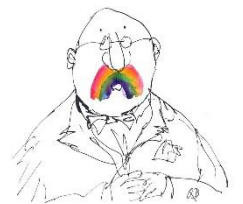
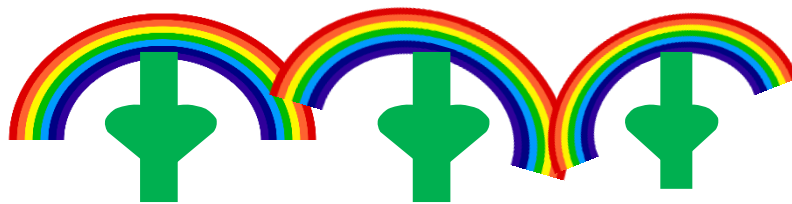


Hello Year 2
