Just to let you know that I put some new reading books on Active Learn last week. I am glad that some of you are reading them as it is very important to keep reading. The more practise you do, the easier it gets.



Keep working through the tasks from earlier in the week. Why not do as White Rose Maths suggests and make a pirate boat and explore floating and sinking. You could do this in your garden.



On a sunny day do a shadow investigation. Draw round your shadow in the morning and again in the afternoon. What has happened to your shadow? Why not draw clothes and faces on your shadows to make them look like you! You could draw round the shadows of some of your toys too.



Draw a number snake in your garden. Write the numbers 1 to 20 on it. Then collect 14 leaves, 12, twigs etc. and put them on the right number. You could organise a number hunt and when you have found all the numbers put them in the correct order.
