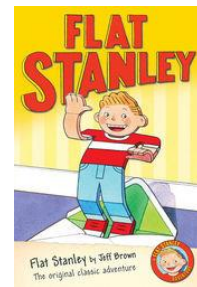

Science:

Light and Shadows

Shadows are made by blocking light. Light rays travel from a source in straight lines. If an opaque object gets in the way, it stops light rays from travelling through it.

Activity:

Create your own shadow puppet show

Shadow puppets are figures that are placed between a light and a screen. Moving them creates the illusion of moving images on the screen. An experienced puppeteer can make figures appear to walk, talk and dance. Shadow puppetry is a popular form of entertainment in countries all over the world.
