



Hi Reception!



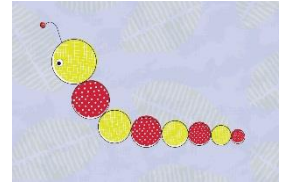
It was lovely to talk to you on Monday. I bet you have grown and look older but you all sounded the same!

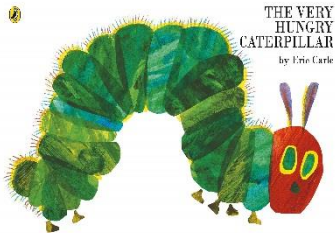
