Science:

What happens when you don't wash your hands?

Equipment:

- 2 slices of fresh bread
- 2 sandwich bags/Ziploc bags

Method:

1. Wash your hands with soap and water for two minutes. You must then dry them thoroughly.
2. Rub your clean and dry hands on the slice of bread and then place it into the Ziploc bag.
3. Get somebody in your house who has not washed their hands recently. Ask them to rub their hands on the other piece of bread. Then place this piece of bread into the other Ziploc bag.
4. Place the two bags in the same location in your house.



5. Observe how the bread changes over time.
