

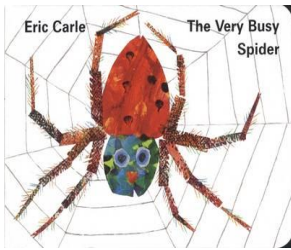


Hi Reception!

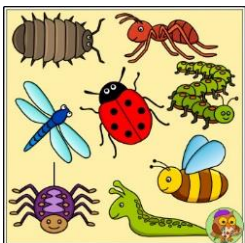
