Making It Right

Raised name foil designs

You will need:

cardboard
tin foil
pva glue
felt tips

Method:

1. Use a pencil to write your name on the cardboard.
2. Add glue over the letters you have just written.
3. (This is the hard bit!) Carefully place the string over the glue.
4. Add glue over the top of the string so that it hardens.
5. Leave to dry
6. Once the string has hardened and the glue has dried, add a layer of tin foil over the piece of cardboard and press it down so that your name appears.
7. Add a splash of colour!
