



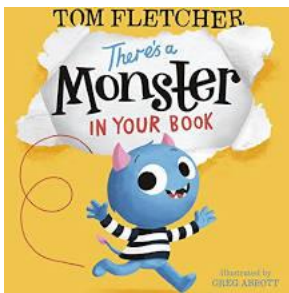
Hi Reception!
