If your child needs to bring a phone to school (eg if they are walking home alone) they need to be kept in the office. There are strict guidelines in place for this due to safeguarding.

### EU settlement scheme:

With the UK departing the EU, people from EEA countries need to make sure that they obtain immigration status to demonstrate their right to stay in the United Kingdom. With this, parents can be eligible for: public services such as healthcare and schools, public funds and pensions and British citizenship, if they meet the requirements and want to apply. The scheme opened on 30th March 2019 and applications must be made by June 2021. It is free to apply to the scheme
