Free School Meals

From the start of the 2026/27 academic year, all pupils from households in receipt of Universal Credit will be entitled to receive a free meal. At the same time, transitional protections will end.

Going forward, there will be two categories of benefits-based Free School Meals:

1. **Targeted FSM** which continues to be based on the existing threshold, covering pupils who are in households in receipt of Universal Credit with annual household earnings of no more than £7,400
2. **Expanded FSM**, a new category covering pupils who do not qualify for targeted FSM, but who are in households receiving Universal Credit.

Households must meet the FSM eligibility criteria to continue receiving provision. If you think you are entitled please click on the link below and register:
