Benedicts Law: Keeping children safe is always our highest priority. We are currently reviewing our procedures in line with Benedict's Law, new guidance that strengthens allergy safety in schools. This guidance helps ensure that children with allergies are supported through clear policies, staff training, emergency response procedures and individual healthcare plans where needed. Parents and carers can help by ensuring that school is fully informed of any allergies their child has and providing up-to-date medical evidence to support this. Including medication where required, and notifying us promptly of any changes to their child's condition. We will be sharing our updated Allergy Policy in the coming weeks and look forward to continuing to work together to keep all children safe, healthy and fully included in school life.

Mobile Phones in School:

If your child brings a mobile phone to school, it must be handed into the school office as soon as they arrive. Phones will be stored securely during the school day and returned to pupils at the end of the day. This helps us to safeguard all children and ensures that mobile devices do not distract from learning or social interactions. Thank you for your support in helping us maintain a safe and focused school environment.
